

Privacy Policy for Lingurum

Effective date: July 13, 2026

This Privacy Policy explains how the Lingurum application handles user information.

1. Personal Data Collection

Lingurum does not require users to create an account and does not request names, addresses, phone numbers, dates of birth, or other information that directly identifies a user.

Learning progress, preferences, and the selected virtual tutor are stored locally on the user's device and are not transmitted to the developer.

2. Microphone Access

Lingurum does not record or transmit the user's voice. Audio content within the application is used solely for listening exercises and learning Czech.

If voice exercises are introduced in a future version, the application will request permission before accessing the microphone, and this Privacy Policy will be updated accordingly.

3. Purchases

Purchases and subscriptions, where available, are processed by Apple through the App Store. Lingurum does not receive or store payment card details or other financial information.

Payment information is processed according to Apple's privacy policies.

4. Support Requests

If a user contacts customer support, the developer may receive the user's email address and the contents of the message.

This information is used only to respond to the request, provide support, and resolve reported issues.

5. Sharing of Information

Lingurum does not sell, rent, or share personal data with advertisers, data brokers, or marketing companies.

Apple may process certain information for App Store distribution, purchases, application delivery, and system diagnostics in accordance with Apple's own privacy policies.

6. Data Storage and Deletion

Locally stored application data remains on the user's device until the application or its data is deleted.

7. Children's Privacy

Lingurum is an educational application and is not designed to collect personal information from children.

The developer does not knowingly collect personal information from users below the minimum age established by applicable law. If such information is discovered, it will be deleted as soon as reasonably possible.
